Christ the King is a house of formation for lifelong missionary disciples of Jesus Christ.

Expectations & Commitments of Student Leaders:

All student leaders are expected to strive to live the Core Values of CTK as follows:

I. Personal Relationship with Christ rooted in the Sacramental Life of the Church:

- DAILY personal prayer.
- Actively live a Sacramental Life. (Mass on Sundays, Confession 1x a month, Daily Mass if possible)
- Desire to grow in spiritual, intellectual, and human formation.
- August 8-11: Participation & Attendance at Leadership Retreat at Stillwater Retreat Center
- Fall Dates TBA: Participation & Attendance at Leadership Nights 3x per semester.
- Weekly participation in leadership formation groups. (FOCUS Discipleship or Household counts)
 - Weekly Leadership Formation is <u>Required</u> for: Committee Heads, SG Leaders, & Tiger Awakening Servantship.
 - o Weekly Leadership Formation is Optional but encouraged for: All other leaders.

II. Mission Oriented:

- Seeking to be a missionary witness by sharing Christ with others and inviting them into the community of CTK and the Sacramental Life of the Church.
- Commitment to your particular apostolate and leadership role.
- Present at CTK's Welcome Week events in the Fall.

III. Humbly Confident:

• Lead with an awareness of your gifts/weaknesses and communicating with both your team and the CTK staff when you need help.

IV. Work as a Team and a Family:

- Committed to building a hospitable, vibrant, and familial community at CTK.
- Work together with CTK Staff to fulfill the CTK mission and vision as related to your particular role.

V. Hard Working:

Committed to the responsibilities of your particular role.

AVAILABLE POSITIONS AND ROLE DESCRIPTIONS:

Small Group Leader:

- Leads and guides a group of peers through a weekly bible study, with the intention of investing in the lives of the study members and walking with them towards a deeper relationship with Jesus.
 - o SG leaders should feel comfortable facilitating conversation and have a heart for others to come to know Jesus through His Word. They can be paired with a co-leader if desired.
- SG leaders must be in a <u>weekly leadership formation group</u> (formerly known as "bible study prep") OR in FOCUS discipleship.
 - o To lead a small group, you should plan on having at least <u>3 hours per week</u> to dedicate towards formation and leading the study.
 - o Study material must be pre-approved by CTK Staff.

Music Ministry:

- Provides music for various events at CTK to aid participants in their prayer and encounter with Jesus.
 - o For example, events like Alive, Encounter, Tiger Awakening, CTK Masses, and more.
- Music Ministry members are required to <u>participate in music ministry meetings</u> throughout the semester.
- Those applying to be part of a group should have a reasonable level of technical musical skill and should be comfortable in the role of leading others in song and prayer.
- To join music ministry, you should plan on having 2-4 hours per week for formation meetings, practice, rehearsal, and performance.

Confirmation Core Team:

- Works with the CTK Confirmation Coordinator to help evangelize, catechize, and integrate candidates for Confirmation into the larger community life of Christ the King.
- Responsibilities will be to attend orientation with Confirmation Coordinator, help facilitate
 conversation during class, invite candidates into the larger community at CTK (social, spiritual,
 intellectual, etc.).
 - o Classes are one night per week for 1.5 hours.
 - o Have <u>one-on-one meetings with candidates</u> to provide a more personal peer connection.

Content Capture (Photography/Videography):

- Captures the ministry of CTK through photos or videos from different events/interviews/ministries as directed by their CTK Staff Mentor.
- They must have their own personal camera to use and provide copies of the content in a timely manner following each task.

EACH COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF:

2 Committee Heads:

- Responsible for leading and investing in their committee members and guiding their committee
 in decision making and implementation. They should be comfortable managing a team, planning
 details, delegating, scheduling, and running meetings, and should be a good communicator.
- They will communicate and work regularly with a CTK staff member.
- Weekly leadership formation is <u>required</u> for committee heads.

5-15 Committee Members:

- Responsible for attending and participating in committee meetings and are expected to take on delegated roles throughout the semester as pertains to what the committee is planning.
 - o Weekly leadership formation is <u>encouraged but not required</u> for committee members.

Social Planning Committee:

- Plans and executes various events and opportunities to nurture the community and invite people into the community in a non-threatening way.
 - o Includes but not limited to: tailgates, dances, men's and women's events.
 - Also helping the Freshman Outreach Committee to plan and execute CTK's Welcome Week in the Fall and various community nights in the Spring.

Service Planning Committee:

- Leads the effort of creating and planning various service events and opportunities that enable the larger CTK community to engage in the Corporal Works of Mercy.
- They are responsible for coming up with service ideas, reaching out to local organizations, and taking initiative to make them happen.

Freshman Outreach Planning Committee:

- Plans and executes outreach to Freshman/First-Year Student community
- Also works in conjunction with the Social Planning Committee to plan and execute CTK's Welcome Week in the Fall, and various community nights in the Spring.
