Thank you for your “yes” to the call to mission! You have dedicated yourself to living Acts 2:42 and living with moral authority. Most importantly, you've committed yourself to putting Christ at the center of your life and following the teachings of the Church.

Living missionary discipleship requires that we commit our minds and hearts both to the Lord and to His mission here on earth. The standards below are the foundations for how we are to conduct ourselves as a community of missionary disciples at LSU. This rule of life has been discerned by the Pastor and leadership team at CTK for our particular community. That said, there are many ways to live out our call to holiness and mission. More than anything, we want to equip you to discern the voice of the Lord throughout the different circumstances of your life.

PRAYER

- Spend at least 30 minutes in consecutive silent mental prayer each day.
 - “We cannot pray ‘at all times’ if we do not pray at specific times, consciously willing it. These are the special times of Christian prayer, both in intensity and duration” (CCC 2697).
 - Pray in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist as often as possible. There is a grace in proximity to the presence of Christ.
- Observe Fridays as a penitential day by either abstaining from meat or participating in some other sacrifice or penance (precept #4 of the Catholic Church).

SACRAMENTAL LIFE

- Attend Sunday Mass and all Holy Days of Obligation.
- Attend Daily Mass as often as you can.
 - Participate in Mass at CTK when possible to pray and worship with our community.
- Go to Confession at least once a month (recommended) or as needed for grave sin.

COMMUNAL LIFE

- Participation and attendance at the CTK Leadership Workshop in August.
- Strive to live a virtuous life in accord with the teachings of the Church and strive for freedom in the Big Three: Chastity, Sobriety, and Excellence.
- Avoid any activities that may lead to scandal and harm the faith of others.

TEACHINGS OF THE APOSTLES

- Attend a discipleship group every week.
- Seek to grow in human, spiritual, intellectual, and apostolic formation through self study.

MISSION

- Serve as a leader in a commissioned discipleship leadership role.
 - Roles that require participation in commissioned discipleship groups at CTK are Bible Study Leader, Discipleship Group Leader, OCIA Core Team Leader, Music Ministry Leader, Cornerstone Cafe Employee, Men’s or Women’s Ministry Head, Community Night Head, and Freshman Outreach Head.
- Offer accountability to your discipleship group leader and other members of the community to live these standards as it is appropriate for each relationship.
